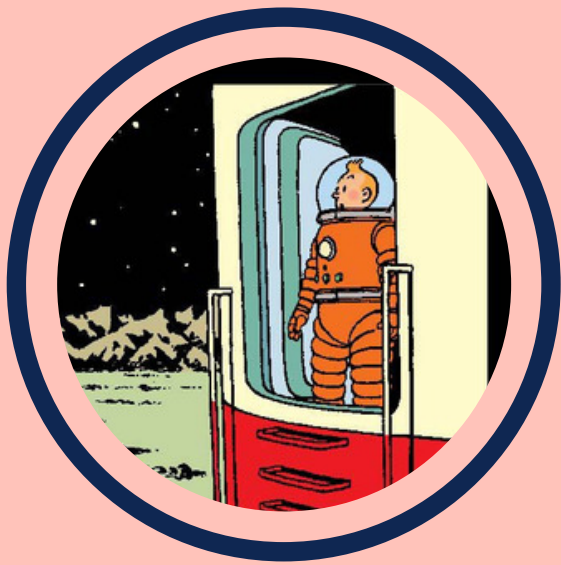


FIVE FREE THINGS
